



### Corporate Affiliate Benefits

- **Individual Corporate Member Benefits** – corporate individual members get all of the benefits of individual benefits;
- **Discount in relation to Member Fees** - Upon payment of the annual corporate affiliate fee (\$550.00 inc GST) individuals within that corporate affiliate firm are able to join at the reduced annual rate of \$110.00 (inc GST), a saving of \$110.00 each;
- **Sponsorship Opportunities** – priority release of the annual sponsorship prospectus which will be issued to the corporate affiliates before distribution to the broader industry so that corporate affiliates can get the first opportunity to take up sponsorship opportunities;
- **Use of Logo and publication of affiliation** – permission to use the SoCLA logo only in relation to being a corporate affiliates of the Society (note not to be used for events or other commercial activities unless approved by SoCLA);
- **Recognition by SOCLA** – all corporate affiliates will be listed on the SoCLA website – in addition SoCLA will acknowledge their corporate affiliates at the conference and other key events; and
- **Account manager** – a dedicated account manager to assist the corporate affiliate with any queries that it may have;

### Individual Member Benefits

- **Forum** – provides a forum for industry and thought leaders to connect and have a positive dialogue to promote change that will benefit the industry;
